



SAAIR CONFERENCE (2016)

Dear participant of the 2016 SAAIR Conference and/or SAHELA workshop.

This communique (an update) serves as source of information to assist you in planning your week for 17-20 October 2016.

Registration:

- Ensure that your registration for the SAHELA workshop and/or the SAAIR Conference was completed in full. If you are not sure, kindly contact Carin Strydom at admin@saair.net
- The SAHELA workshop is presented in Building C1, Room 135, registration takes place in front of Room 135. The Registration (Collection of bag, name card etc) for the SAHELA workshop (Monday 17 October 2016) is from 08:00-08:50. Coffee/Tea available.
- Registrations have closed and the numbers finalised for the SAHELA Workshop, the Conference, the Conference Cocktail, Bus Tour and Gala event. Only those who registered for these events will be provided for.
- At the registration desk, registered delegates will receive a conference bag with all the required conference proceedings, etc.
- The publication: Institutional Research in South African Higher Education Intersecting Contexts and Practices. 2016. Botha, J & Muller NJ (eds). SUN PRESS, must be personally collected and signed for by each registered **conference delegate** at the registration desk on **Tuesday 18 October 2016**.

Prior to you departure for Potchefstroom, kindly note the following:

- If you are driving a vehicle you will need to show your driver's licence to security at the gate to gain access to the campus.
- Bring along enough business cards. You are allowed to place your business card into two bowls/boxes upon registering. At the **end of each session** one attendee's name will be randomly drawn and this person will receive a (very) small but memorable gift (if the person is present in the room).
- If you are planning to drive to Potchefstroom from OR Tambo International Airport (approx. 150 km) it is recommended that you **consider the time of day.** Traffic during peak hours can be a very challenging factor. The quality of the road is good. Speeding cameras are definitely working on this route. Be very cautious at all times. Please expect delays due to traffic early in the morning (06:30-08:00) and late in the afternoon (after 16:30).
- If you plan to travel to Potchefstroom from Lanseria International Airport (approx. 150km) expect less traffic, slightly worse road conditions at times, and always the omnipresent traffic police with their speeding cameras. If you have a GPS it is recommended that you travel via Tarlton (N14) and not via Krugersdorp CBD.

- Note that no provision has been made for bus transport to the conference venue or any of the evening functions. If you do not drive there yourself, ensure that you have a colleague to travel with at all times. Detailed maps to these venues are included in the conference proceedings.

- The entrance gate (pictured below) (If you are the driver of a vehicle you require your SA Driver's Licence to gain access and to exit).



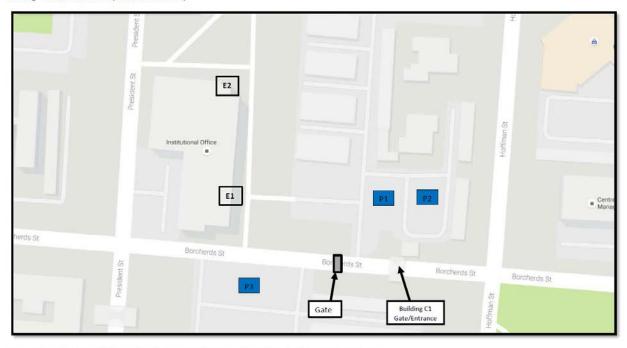
Entrance Gate, Building C1, North-West University

- Room 145 (also Wi-Fi equipped) is next to Room 135 and is available should you require space to sit and work.
- Room 211a (on the second floor) is available for SAAIR Exco meetings. The key to this venue is held by one of the organisers, Tommy Pietersen (084 328 0159).
- The dress code for the Gala event is casual/smart. (There is no Wi-Fi connectivity at the Gala event).
- The building in which the Conference is hosted can at times be very busy as it houses several managers' offices as well as support departments of the NWU.
- Conference delegates are requested to wear the conference name card at all times during the day as these name cards serve as conference identification and will also ensure your access to coffee/tea and lunch/dinner areas.
